

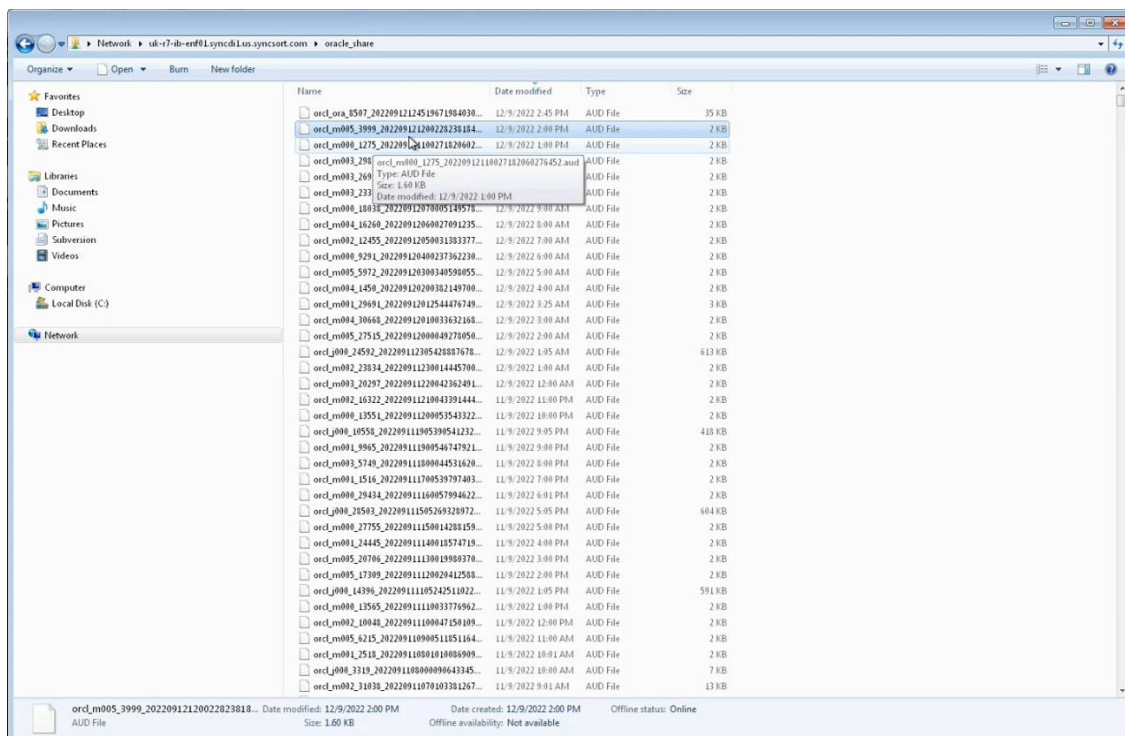
# Import Oracle SYSDBA users audit events for Unix/Linux systems

You can import audit events of Oracle SYSDBA users from Unix and Linux systems into CPA.

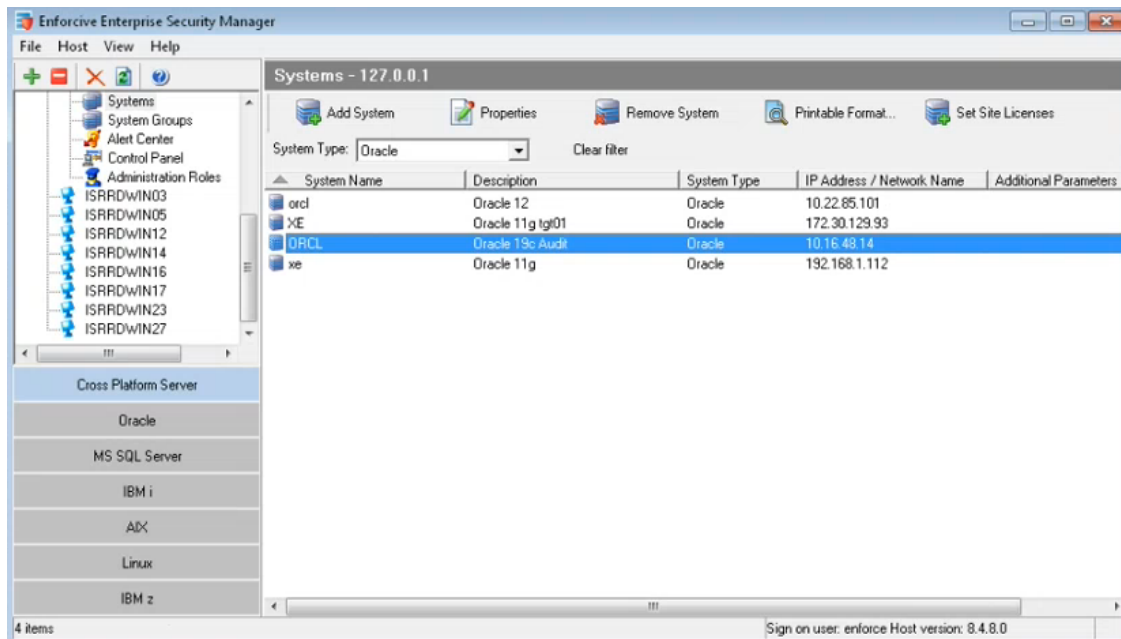
Follow these steps to import Oracle audit events:

## Event Transfer Definition

1. Define a Share folder on the Oracle server.



2. In the Systems module in CPA, define the Oracle Server system.

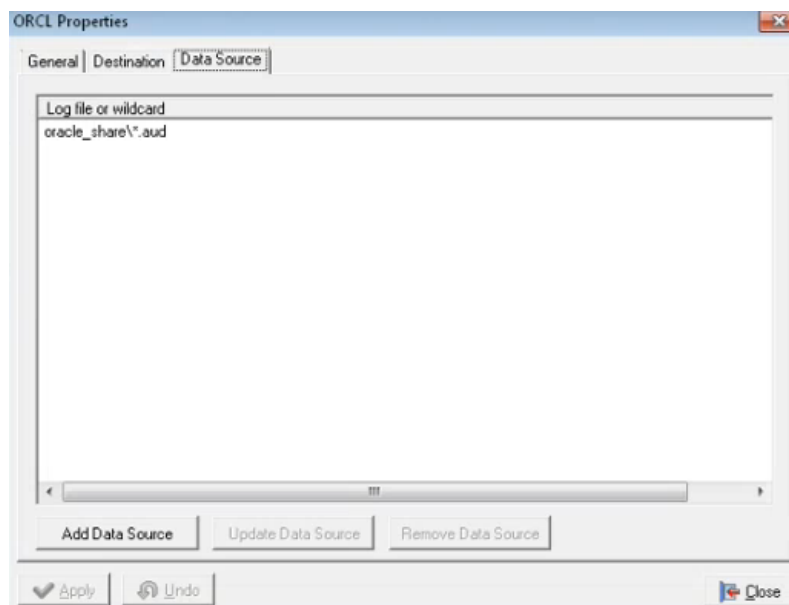


- Click Add System.
- On the System Type panel, select Oracle. Click Next.
- On the System Properties panel, enter the system information. Click Finish to save the system definition.

3. In the CPA Data Providers module, define a Data Provider for the Oracle server.
  - a) Select Oracle as the Data Provider type.
  - b) Click Add System. On the Add System to Data Provider panel, select the Oracle server from which you want to import audit events. Click Next.
  - c) On the Destination panel, select CPA (Central Data Repository). Click Next.



- d) On the Data Source panel, select the Oracle Share folder. Click Finish to save the Data Provider.





## **Start/Stop Transfer**

The Data Provider will automatically update the event log with new events, according to the Wait time between processes defined for it.

Note: You can stop and resume the transfer process via the Activate and Deactivate buttons.
